OR1 Lady Marine Rose lost one of our member, Tiffany Ojeda Hill was killed by her husband on November 26, 2019 .

Sergeant Tiffany Ojeda-Hill was born in Brooklyn, New York in 1984 and was a graduate of John Dewey High School in Brooklyn. Even as a youngster, Tiffany was not one to sit around idle. It was at John Dewey High School that Tiffany refined her passion for baking. Before joining the Marine Corps, Tiffany volunteered with the NYPD Explorer Program.

Tiffany served from 2005-2010 in the United States Marine Corps as a 7413, (UAV) Unmanned Arial Vehicle Operator. Tiffany joined the Lady Marine Rose Chapter in 2017. Sgt. Tiffany Hill, a veteran Marine, was needlessly failed by a system that does not comprehend the ripple effects of domestic violence. Sgt. Tiffany Hill has been called to guard the gates of heaven and has left her legacy as a beacon of light in a world full of chaos..

Once again we held our monthly meeting at the King Center Senior Village..

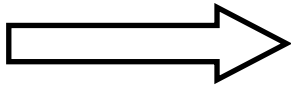
We are making good things happen in our community. And growing our network of women that served “sisterhood “ .



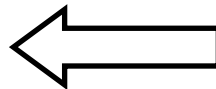
November events—

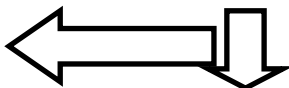
Nov 8th— Our two best LEs Paulie & John Stofiel taming the morning shift, at **Ashley Home Furniture**. Thank you for supporting us!



Nov 8th— Thank you Carson for standing watch and keeping us safe while we collect donations and educate the public about our organization.

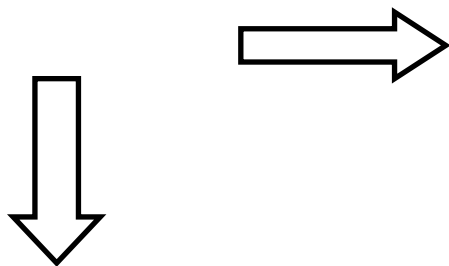

And we had a lot of interest & activity at our vendor table! We signed up several new people to our email list and sold a number of the litter bags handmade by our members!

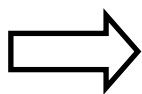

How does OR- 1 Celebrate the big 244th?

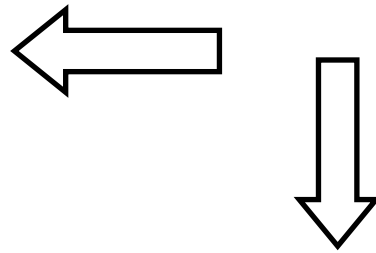
By hosting a motivated Marine Corps Bday Workout that's how.

Thank you Antoniette Sanders and **Woodstock CrossFit** for putting this event together for us, we had a blast.

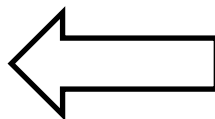

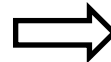
Cristina Peralta Cernusak & Her husband Jeremy Cernusak were honored as the Home Town Heroes for the Nov 10th Blazer game .
